ERASMUS+ MOBILITY

The European Union's Erasmus+ programme offers doctoral students several opportunities for academic and professional development.

Erasmus+ Study Mobility

Studies take place at one of DU's partner universities.

During the mobility period, students complete courses that fully or partially correspond to the study courses of their DU programme.

Erasmus+ Intership Mobility

The doctoral student carries out activities related to the preparation of their doctoral thesis in a company, research institute, laboratory, organisation, higher education institution, or any other appropriate workplace (including during the summer months).

Note: Intership mobility can also be completed **after graduation** in *recent graduate* status. This must be undertaken **within one year after graduation**. The doctoral student must submit the application in their final semester before graduating from DU.

Duration of Study and Intership Mobility

- **Long-term mobility:** 2-12 months
- Short-term mobility: 5-30 days (especially suitable for doctoral students who cannot participate in long-term mobility)

Scholarship

Participants going abroad for study or traineeship mobility receive an Erasmus+ grant to cover travel and living expenses. Additional support is available for participants with fewer opportunities.
